### INFORMATION ON THE POSTER TOUR

- Poster tours gather the most outstanding posters submitted in 2024 and consist of several guided tours around the best posters in various categories. During the tours, the poster presenters will have the opportunity to present, explain the main results of their work and answer questions during an interactive discussion.
- The tour will start at the corresponding poster tour station.
- Please be present at the poster tour area, 5 minutes before the start of the tour. When the moderators arrive, introduce yourself and wait for your turn.
- Please give a short presentation of approximately 4 minutes to present the highlights of your work.
- Please ensure that your presentation does not run over the time allocated.
- After the short presentation, the tour guide will lead an interactive discussion with the participants attending the tour.
- Handouts of your abstract / poster (with your contact details) may facilitate future communication.
- The way your poster is arranged is of prime importance to facilitate this short presentation, during which you will only be able to stress the key elements. So, you need to be clear what these are and be aware how to explain them in a short time.

### YOUR SHORT POSTER TOUR PRESENTATION

#### ➤ **Presentation Length:**

For a **6-minute poster tour presentation**, we recommend **4 minutes of presentation** and **2 minutes for questions** and audience discussion.

#### ➤ **Tips and Tricks for your Short Presentation:**

Ask yourself the following questions to give the most effective and powerful short presentation:

- What is my goal for this presentation?
- What is the most important message I want listeners to leave with?
- If I wrote a one sentence description of my presentation, what would it say?

- If I were to write a list of the keywords for the presentation, what words would be on the list?
- What is the theme? And what are the three major points?
- What action do I want audience members to take upon hearing my presentation?

➤ **Preparation:**

You will have to produce a **poster** as supporting material and be present in front of your poster at the indicated time in your notification letter.

➤ **Poster tour moderator:**

Please meet the moderator at your poster **at least five (5) minutes prior to the start of your scheduled poster tour.**

➤ **Rules and Regulations:**

All presentations must be made in **English**. The use of an interpreter is not permitted.

## POSTER DESIGN

- It is mandatory to indicate your new abstract number in the upper right corner of the poster.
- Don't overload your poster. Remember, you are not writing an article.
- Seek simplicity, keep text to a minimum and avoid redundancies.
- Handouts of your abstract / poster (with your contact details) to your interested readers may facilitate future research communication.
- QR codes linking to scientific content can be included on the poster.

## POSTER DIMENSIONS

- Orientation format: **Portrait**
- Recommended size: **A0 Format (1189mm of height and 841 mm of width)**

## POSTER DISPLAY AT THE CONGRESS

**Poster boards:**

Each poster board is numbered, corresponding with your final abstract number and in the topic your abstract was submitted under.

**Fixation:**

Material will be provided on site in the poster area. Push pins, staples, etc. are NOT allowed.

**Set-up and dismantle:**

Authors are fully responsible for the set up and dismantling of their poster according to the schedule available on our website.
